INTRODUCTION

Gender-based violence (GBV) is a global pandemic that affects 1 in 3 women in their lifetime. The United Nations defines violence against women (VAW) as "any act of gender-based violence that results in, or is likely to result in, physical, sexual, or mental harm or suffering to women, including threats of such acts, coercion or arbitrary deprivation of liberty, whether occurring in public or in private life."

Violence against women and girls in Pakistan manifests in multi-faceted, interrelated, and recurring forms; it includes physical, sexual, psychological, emotional and economic abuse and exploitation, occurring in both private and public spaces and are grounded in elements of situational and socio-cultural factors. Research confirms that gender-based violence is an unfortunate and dire reality in present day Pakistan, where it is often uniquely legitimized in the name of culture, tradition and morality.

In Punjab, reported cases of violence against women have steadily increased over time. However, rising trends of reporting have also been noted in Punjab due to active and helpful institutional mechanisms, such as police helpline 15, 36 Women Protection Centers across the province, 12 SBB Human Rights Centers, 36 Darul Amans, women police stations, medico-legal services in public hospitals, and helps desks for women at police stations.

Survivors' journey to recovery would undeniably be smooth if services accessible to them ensure their safety, including preventing and mitigating further violence; protect their confidentiality; demonstrate respect for survivors' needs and wishes and promote their right to make their own choices; and practice nondiscrimination, ensuring that survivors, in all their diversity, are able to access and receive appropriate services and meaningful support.

This resource directory comprises of contact information for essential services that can be used by survivors themselves, their families, service providers, media persons who wish to report incidences of violence, and any other person who wishes to aid a survivor in her journey to recovery and rehabilitation. It contains information that will be helpful in times of emergency, when a survivor wishes to report an occurrence, obtain legal information, get medical aid, including psychological help, explore options for emergency and long-term housing, obtain admission in skill development or vocational training programs, and get microfinance to commence entrepreneurial ventures.



Methodology of Compilation and Limitations

This directory comprises of essential services for survivors of violence in Lahore, Gujrat, Sargodha, Rawalpindi, Sialkot and Nankana Sahib, in the following order:

- Resources from Punjab Women Protection Authority
- Police helplines, Khidmat Markaz and Sub-divisional Police Officers
- ☐ Healthcare and medico-legal service providers
 ☐
- Legal Aid and Mediation service providers
- Shelter homes and Orphanages
- Financial aid and Microfinance service providers
- ☑ Opportunities for skill development and/or vocational training

The services listed in this directory have been obtained through field and online research, as well as telephonic interviews with key service providers and stakeholders. Phone numbers of police resources have been verified from the police helpline and website. Details of addresses, and telephone numbers are listed along with the mention of, where applicable, focal persons to be contacted to obtain services swiftly. Although each district has more than 5 police stations on average, it is not recommended that phone numbers of police stations be included in this directory, since they are rarely in order. Furthermore, all people using this directory must also be advised that in case the police resources listed herein are not available or accessible, the toll free police helpline (15) is responsive 24/7 and must be used extensively.

The Punjab Women Protection Authority (PWPA) was created via the Punjab Women Protection Authority Act of 2018 and has been operational in Punjab since then. However, their jurisdiction was limited to the district of Multan, until November 2022, when an Order of the Lahore High Court and subsequent notification by the Provincial Government of Punjab extended their authority to all districts of the province. Since then, as per its statutory mandate, the PWPA has spent considerable resources to mobilize all stakeholders under one roof; police, medico-legal services, legal aid, prosecution, sessions courts, shelter homes, and psychological services to respond to domestic violence. The objective of institutionalizing an Authority like the PWPA is to bring all essential services for survivors of domestic violence under one roof, so that a survivor only needs to contact one service provider i.e. the Women Protection Officer or the District Women Protection Officer through a Punjab-wide helpline (1737) who may connect the survivor with relevant services subsequently. Although a concrete effort in essence, it is notable to mention here, that the PWPA's resources are not entirely active at the moment. Therefore, survivors, resource and support persons are advised to contact police helplines and relevant numbers as primary emergency contacts, and subsequently get medico-legal and prosecutorial help, if so desired. Alternatively, district shelter homes (darul aman) may be approached at any time of day, week and month as well.



Over the years, the Government of Punjab has successfully set up a vast range of services for survivors of gender based violence. This includes a large network of police stations across the province, gender desks and female police officers at police stations, women police stations in some districts, a vibrant police helpline (15), 36 shelter homes, 12 SBB Human Rights Centers for Women, "help centers" (Khidmat Markaz) for swift action, anti-harassment cells in some districts, special courts for prosecution of gender based violence cases, legal aid schemes for women, shelter homes, district women protection systems, and skill development and vocational training centers for welfare of women. Female work force of the Punjab Police, Punjab Public Prosecution Service, District Judiciary, and Social Welfare and Bait-ul-Maal Department, Government of Punjab, are frequently sensitized on the needs of gender based violence survivors, and implementation of a survivor centered approach with due respect for human rights of all survivors.

Districts Lahore, Gujrat, Sargodha, Rawalpindi, Sialkot, and Nankana Sahib differ in terms of size, population, urbanization, and thus also availability of support services for survivors of gender based violence. Lahore, being the largest geographically and according to population, has a number of police resources across the city, active helplines, more shelters for women compared to other cities, greater opportunities for skill development and vocational training, and overall, a greater variety of services. Nankana Sahib is on the other end of the spectrum; a small city albeit in close proximity to Lahore, with fewer options of shelter homes, local helplines, legal aid and skill development.

It is pertinent to mention here, that the Punjab Women Protection Authority (PWPA) has a vibrant system currently being established across the province. As per the mandate of the PWPA, all mechanisms for support of domestic violence survivors are to operate under one roof, i.e., through the PWPA and its women protection centers or "violence against women centers" (as the one in Multan is called). The system envisaged by the Punjab Women Protection Authority Act of 2018 and its parent legislation, the Punjab Protection of Women against Violence Act of 2016, is led by a District Women Protection Officer, who is contacted directly by a survivor of domestic violence, and who must accompany the survivor when she accesses all redress available, including lodging a police report, getting a medico-legal examination conducted, registering an FIR against the alleged perpetrator, obtaining shelter at a secure shelter home, accessing legal aid and psycho-social counseling services, and finally attempting social and economic rehabilitation through skill development and job placement. As per the Act, all of the aforementioned service providers must be members of a District Women Protection Committee, which is headed by the District Women Protection Officer, to coordinate and liaise with all relevant stakeholders.

However, for the last 5 years, operation of the PWPA was limited to Multan. Since November 2022, the PWPA has been granted jurisdiction across the Punjab; however, active and successful operation of all mechanisms will take due time. In the meantime, other resources listed in this directory should be used for service delivery to survivors of gender based violence.
